PARMA GAZEBO SITE UNDER CONSTRUCTION

(PARMA) – Parma Service Department workers are repairing a collapsed storm sewer near the gazebo at Ridgewood Lake Park. The repairs will be completed by the end of July.

A portion of the construction site area is off limits due to safety concerns, but the park remains open.

City officials remind residents they can utilize the new gazebo at James W. Day Park, formerly Nike Park, on Pleasant Valley Road. The gazebos are always popular locations for public use and special event picture-taking.

Both parks have outdoor swimming pools, a playground and picnic pavilions. They are open for summer activities from June through August.

James W. Day Park also has four softball fields, eight soccer fields, an outdoor basketball court, hiking and exercise trails and concession stands.

The park is named after former Parma Mayor James W. Day.
